




#### Exploring our Sage Developer Site

Hello Readers,

Today we are going to be exploring our Sage Developer site. Lately I have been getting inquires on APIs and REST information. I figured it was a good time to write a short blog on our developer site where you can find all sorts of information on APIs, REST, GraphQL and more. Originally, in the beginning, the developer site mainly helped developers with XML/JSON calls for our Web server component. It shows samples on how to use SOAPUI to make calls to/from the system. Fast forward several years; now the site has several options for developing like REST and GraphQL. I am going to show you how you can find this information and where you can go to get started on your own development.

So, it all starts at the website. You will want to navigate via your preferred browser to <u>https://developer.sage.com/</u>. It should take you to the main site and look very similar to mine (if you're on a smart device it will scale so it won't exactly look like mine).

  - Sage certify at the "top" level, latest patches can be applied
    - e.g. If using SQL Server 2016 with V12 Patch 22, you can apply the latest patches available for SQL Server 2016, but would need to upgrade to Patch 23 or above before upgrading to SQL Server 2019

- Apache 2.2 or 2.4
  - 2.4 is **highly** recommended
    - Sage certify at the "top" level, latest patches can be applied
  - How to upgrade 2.2 to Apache 2.4
    - <u>https://online-help.sageerpx3.com/erp/12/public/index.html</u>
  - Apache vulnerabilities
    - <u>https://httpd.apache.org/security/vulnerabilities\_24.html</u>
    - Setup your firewall rules so that the Apache installation (configured for Sage X3 use only) can only be accessed by the X3 server(s) that need the access to Apache.
  - Apache will be optional in future version (Expected in 2022 R2)
    - Syracuse will take over the role Apache was playing



- JDK
  - JDK 8 is mandatory, due to installation requirements of the MongoDB component (4.x)
  - Can install multiple JDK versions, for example if you wish to use latest certified JDK that Elastic Search supports
  - How to replace Oracle JRE/JDK by Zulu JRE/JDK
    - <u>https://online-help.sageerpx3.com/erp/12/public/index.html</u>
    - You don't have to use Zulu, for example can use OpenJDK
