History of Changes in 2022 Update 2b



Below are the details of the changes made to our latest software release.

Enhancements

- PPP-7518 – The setup for GL Integration is now included in the company backup.
- PPP-7944 – The YTD value for tax total 4001 will now include both the employee and employer portions contributed.
- PPP-7951 – When integrating payroll information to Sage 50c V18 or later, you can now enter a journal reference.
- PPP-7953 – A new report has been added to display the setup for integrations to Sage 200 (Evolution).
- PPP-7967 – 1 November 2021 has been added as a public holiday in South Africa.
- PPP-7975 – You are now able to generate the UIF Electronic declaration from a year-end period.
- PPP-7982 – You will now be able to add a directive for lump sum amounts during the year-end period.

Defects

- PPP-7576 – Columns 3 & 5 will no longer wrap on the Audit Trial report.
- PPP-7889 - When back dating termination for a Resident/Non-Resident non-executive director you will no longer get a payslip exception to add the income transactions to the current payslip.
- PPP-7954 – The integration setup will no longer disappear when renaming a company database.
- PPP-7970 – Nett pay rounding will now calculate correctly when an employee is placed on leave while selected to not use BCEA rates and Nett pay rounding is enabled.
- PPP-7976 – Transactions 6400, 6410 & 6411 will no longer be pre-selected to pro-rata.

Councils

- PPP-7956 – NBCEI – The required changes for Areas J & K have been finalised and updated on the relevant lookup tables and transactions.
- PPP-7986 – Security – The provident fund percentage has been decreased.

International

- PPP-7958 – Botswana – The ITW8 will now only print employees with zero tax when the selection to include such employees has been made.
- PPP-7972 – Zimbabwe – The NSSA Electronic P4 template has been updated.
- PPP-7973 – Nigeria – Changes to various transactions' formulas relating to the consolidation allowance relief has been applied.
- PPP-7978 – Zimbabwe – The NSSA will no longer print termination dates for employees that are not terminated in that period.
