Legislative changes

BCEA Earnings Threshold Increase 2023/24

The Minister of Employment and Labour published a [Government Notice](#) increasing the BCEA earnings threshold from R224 080,48 per annum to R241 110,59 per annum effective 1 March 2023.

National Minimum Wage Increase

The Minister of Employment and Labour published a [Government Notice](#) increasing the national minimum wage from R23,19 per hour to R25,42 per hour effective 1 March 2023. The R25,42 per hour rate also applies to farm workers and domestic workers, an increase from R23,19. While the rate for per hour for workers employed on an expanded public works programme is R13,97, an increase from R12,75.

OID Earnings Threshold

The Director General of Employment and Labour published a [Government Notice](#), increasing the OID earnings threshold from R529 264 per annum to R563 520 per annum effective 1 March 2023 (2023/2024 year of assessment).
